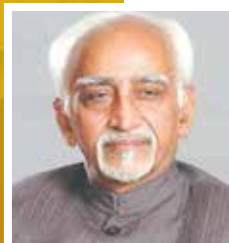

THE INSTITUTE

Chandragupt Institute of Management Patna (CIMP) was established as an autonomous institution with active support from the Government of Bihar. The institute was laid down the objective of contributing substantially to the academic and development credentials of Bihar, while fulfilling the primary role of training students to become professional managers. CIMP offers a two-year full-time Post Graduate Diploma in Management, approved by AICTE and accredited by NBA. Shortly the institute is introducing new programmes as Fellow Programme in Management (equivalent to PhD like IIMs) and Executive Programmes for Corporates and Government Officials. In a short span of 8 years, CIMP has proved its worth to the corporate world and has been able to place its graduates in various companies of national and international repute, such as Amul, GIC HFL, LIC HFL, Colgate Palmolive, ICICI Bank, ITC, NDDDB, Tata Advanced Systems & Yes Bank.



Vision

To become a nationally and internationally relevant management education and research institution focusing on excellence.



Mission

To focus on enriching the management education profile of Bihar through training, research and consulting activities. To establish centers of research especially focusing on the development issues of Bihar

INFRASTRUCTURE

Our eco friendly campus is located in Mithapur, which is 4 kms away from Patna airport and 1.5 kms away from Patna railway station. It's a state-of-the-art academic cum residential campus spread over 10 acres of land. The campus consists of an Academic Block, MDP Block, Auditorium, two hostels for boys and girls, Extracurricular Activity Block, accommodation for teaching & non-teaching staff, guest house for visiting faculty and eminent guests, along with the director's residence. CIMP's academic block has four large lecture halls and several additional classrooms along with Computer Facility Centre, Language Lab & Library. The entire campus is Wi-Fi enabled. All classrooms and conference rooms are air conditioned and are well equipped with LCD screens and projectors to facilitate learning and interaction. The campus will have an International Management Education Centre with outreach campuses in other countries like Fiji and Mauritius later.



Auditorium

The 500 seater, centrally air conditioned, auditorium is another unique facility in CIMP. The hub of all co-curricular activities, the auditorium regularly hosts eminent personalities. It has already hosted several programs such as SPICMACAY cultural programs, annual business fest, seminars, industry interactions and annual convocation. The auditorium is equipped with ultra-modern equipment including professional audio-visual systems.

Library

The state-of-the-art Library Resource Centre (LRC) is a major facilitator of CIMP's teaching, learning, training, and research activities. The library resource centre is one of the best in the country. The library has the facility to access e-resources as part of its resource collaboration with Harvard Business School Publishing (HBSP), and INDEST-AICTE Consortium, jointly established by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) and IIT Delhi, and Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET), Ahmedabad. The library stocks (all within very short period of 7 years) more than 16,400 books, 200 print journals, 138 newspapers - prints and online, 600 government publications, 2000 Harvard classic collections, 500 handbooks and non-book materials, including 900 CDs received with books, 100 videos and 200 audio collections. Students can access more than

Information Technology (IT) is an integral part of the success of any leading management institute. Therefore, IT and e-enablement at the campus is a critical component of CIMP's focus towards excellence. CIMP's strategy provides visibility of services and assets, control of information and systems and automation of tasks and processes.

10,000+ full text journal titles through EBSCO, J-Gate. The library also subscribes to business databases such as PROWESS, Socio-Economic Statistics database such as Indiatat, Legal research database such as SCC Online Web Edition Platinum Plus and latest statistical software like SPSS 18, AMOS 18, PASW 13, Clementine, Stata, E views and reference management software like EndNote. The Library offers user services such as RFID Automated System, Document Delivery Service, WebOpac powered by VTLS, Bibliographic Service, Institutional Repository, Open Video Digital Library, Virtual Reference Service, etc. The students have 24 hours access to the library; they can also access the library online from their hostel rooms.

Language Lab

CIMP has started a standalone Language Lab for language tutorials. Those students who opt for remedial English classes get additional support through this Lab. This especially benefits students who have any deficiency in English. This also helps students for interviews and competitive examinations. The Lab is equipped with latest audio-visual devices.

Quality Improvement Cell (QIC)

Quality Improvement Cell has been developed for the students to promote self-learning and to learn beyond the syllabus to enhance knowledge.

RESEARCH & CONSULTING ACTIVITIES

CIMP's faculty is engaged in cutting-edge research in the field of management. The publications and conference presentations bear testimony to the research quality produced by CIMP's internal faculty team. Faculty members have presented their research papers at many international conferences. Moreover, many research papers of CIMP's faculty have been accepted for publication in international journals. Faculty members bring their research output and insights to PGP classrooms which enrich classroom discussions.

CIMP is playing a leading role in contributing to the all round development of the nation. Therefore, research areas, which have high contextual relevance and development implications for Bihar and India, in the next two decades, have been identified for starting CIMP's research centres. This is in addition to areas relevant to the Corporate World. The institute organizes conferences, workshops and seminars on a regular basis on these areas.

MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES (MDPs)

A major activity at CIMP is designing, developing and conducting innovative Management Development Programmes (MDPs) to train managers in the state of Bihar and rest of India. In this fast-changing business environment, working executives need to update themselves regularly and CIMP equips them with knowledge, skills and attitude required for delivering their best.

The MDPs are designed to provide insight into managerial concepts with a view to implementing strategies in functional areas. The MDPs also help the practicing managers by providing overall perspective for decision making and integrating functional and general management approaches.

So far, CIMP has successfully conducted 144 MDPs. Some major clients are ICDS-Dept. of Social Welfare, Govt. of Bihar, Department of Posts-Bihar Circle, Power Grid Corporation of India, Bihar Police Service, District Education Officers, Govt. of Bihar, Bihar School Examination Board, Mahila Samakhya-Bihar, Jeevika, District Programme Officers, Govt. of Bihar.

The MDP Complex can accommodate 104 participants at a time. It also has state-of-the-art class rooms with wi-fi facilities, seminar rooms and conference rooms.



PROGRAMME DESIGN - PGP

The residential two-year full-time NBA accredited Post Graduate Diploma in Management prepares students for careers in various industries. The programme is designed to enhance the problem solving and decision making abilities of students and to create awareness on the socio-economic environment. The aim of the program is to produce managers with socially desirable values. CIMP students are exposed to latest developments in the management discipline. During the first year of the programme, students learn basic concepts in the areas of Business Communication, Finance & Accounting, Marketing, Systems, Organizational Behaviour, Human Resource Management and Operations & Quantitative Techniques. These core courses help the students in building a sound foundation in various functional areas.

The programme offers a pool of electives in the Second Year in various functional areas of management such as marketing, finance, human resources, and operations. A student can distribute his/her choice of electives across one or more of the functional areas, subject to completion of the minimum number of credits required for the award of PGDM. The students are exposed to the case-based teaching methodology supported by at least 300 cases from Harvard Publications. Simulations, live projects, field assignments and role plays are integral part of the curriculum. Academic and research collaborations have been initiated with University of Lehigh for student exchange programme and other research activities.

LIFE @ CIMP

A lot of learning in a business school happens outside the classrooms. At CIMP, campus life outside classrooms is full of activity, learning and enthusiasm. CIMP has several groups, committees and clubs run by students which make the campus life vibrant.



Academic Committee

The committee plays an important role in upholding and developing the academic standards at CIMP. It is an interface between the students, teachers and the PGP office which assists in collating student's feedback, arranging remedial classes and helping students enhance their communication skills.

Saarang – The Cultural Committee

Saarang, the cultural committee, is responsible for organizing and managing all cultural events at CIMP. 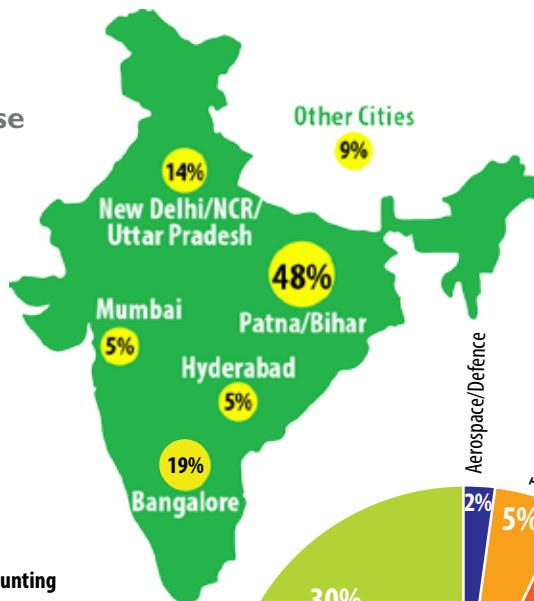

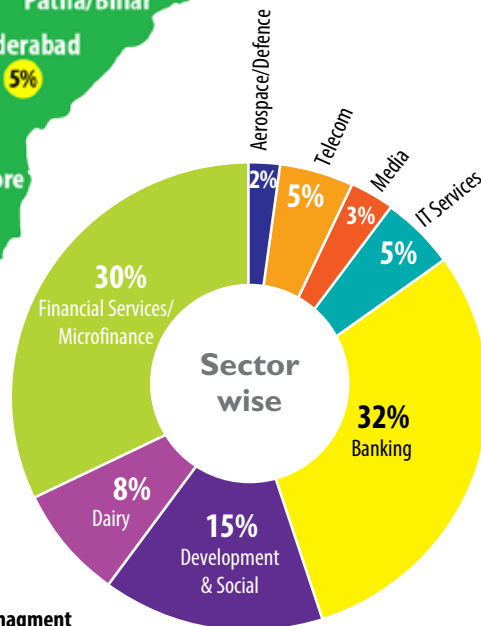
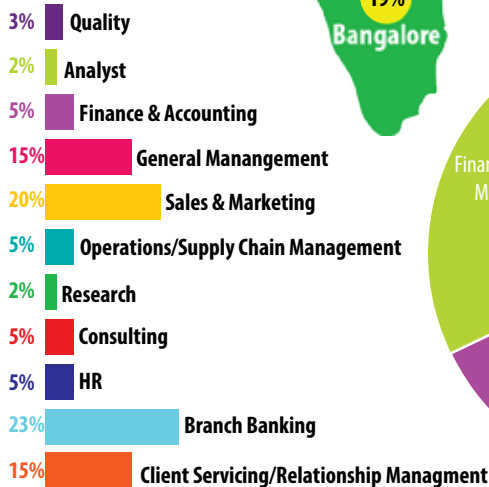
FINAL PLACEMENTS 2016
