Re: Audit of Placement Report for 2022-24 placements of Post Graduate Diploma in Business Management and Post Graduate Diploma in Human Resource Management programmes of XLRI - Xavier School of Management

We have audited the data related to remuneration, function & location as presented in the Placement Report prepared by XLRI - Xavier School of Management for the final placement (based on the offers received and accepted on campus) of the 2022-24 batch of Post Graduate Diploma in Business Management and Post Graduate Diploma in Human Resource Management programmes of XLRI - Xavier School of Management. The preparation of the Placement Report is the responsibility of XLRI. Our responsibility is to validate the information related to salary, function & location as provided in the report with the relevant documentation and comment on the conformance of those with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards (IPRS) Revision 2.2.

In this context, we confirm the following:

1. For the purpose of the audit, we have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary. In our opinion, the Placement Report complies with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards Revision 2.2.
2. The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by XLRI from recruiting companies. B2K Analytics (formerly Brickworks Analytics) has not independently sourced any information or documentation directly from the recruiters.

3. We have verified the information with respect to salary, function & location as presented in the report with the communication received by XLRI from the recruiters.
 - a. The information has been categorised as best as possible under different salary heads as given in the IPRS Revision 2.2; where a break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
 - b. The data points mentioned under different salary heads are representative of aggregate salary components offered to the candidates.
 - c. Stock Options (ESOPs)/ESPP have been mentioned for some students with details on the amount to be vested in the first year. Hence, the corresponding fixed amount has been considered for the calculation of the 'Maximum Earning Potential' (MEP). In cases where the vesting schedule was not specified, we have assumed that 25% of the ESOPs will vest in the first year.
 - d. Long-Term benefits (to be paid after twelve months) like ESOPs, retention bonus and any other long-term benefit (if mentioned in the offer letter) to be paid after the first year have not been considered for the calculation of MEP.
 - e. We have considered the amount of gratuity in the calculation of MEP even though it is payable after 5 years of continuous service as this amount was not separately available for all the candidates.
 - f. Wherever information about the job location and function of students could not be established from the documents, and where offer letters were not signed, the details have been confirmed by the institute. An official declaration regarding the same has been obtained from the Placement Convenor.
 - g. Wherever information was missing reasonable assumptions have been made.
4. The acceptance of offers and the number of students opting out of the placement process has been established through written communication from those students.
 - a. Out of 503 students eligible for placements, 5 students opted out of the placement process.



5. While auditing the data it was observed that not all the students have been offered one-time cash payments like joining bonus, retention bonus etc. Therefore, the average of one-time cash payments, represents the average of one-time cash payments actually received by the students and not the average of all the students.
6. We have only audited the data related to salary, function & location in the placement report and not the report's overview section, which explains the placement process.

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Overview

XLRI Jamshedpur and XLRI Delhi NCR have triumphantly secured 100% placements for the graduating class of 2022-24 across their esteemed Two-year PGDM (BM) and Two-year PGDM (HRM) programs, with all, 503 students receiving job offers in the Final Recruitment Process. This placement process unfolded in two phases. Initially, the Lateral Recruitment Process (LRP) catered to candidates with prior work experience, offering them positions above the entry level. Subsequently, the Campus Recruitment Process (CRP) was implemented, wherein candidates were considered without regard to their previous work experience. A total of 154 recruiting entities participated, extending 519 domestic and 1 international offer, which included 65 new recruiters. Notably, pre-placement offers (PPOs) were extended to 33.39% of the cohort, reflecting the exceptional performance of these students during their Summer Internships. Candidates from both the Jamshedpur and Delhi NCR campuses were involved in this comprehensive placement endeavour.

Placement Process

The placement processes at XLRI happen in 2 stages – Lateral Recruitment Process (LRP) and Campus Recruitment Process (CRP). LRP involves participation of students with a prior work experience with firms offering niche and senior-level managerial positions to the students. CRP involved a semi-cohort process with firms participating across multiple roles across multiple functional domains.

Top Recruiters

The top segments based on roles offered were Consulting, ITES, E-Commerce, Sales & Marketing and General Management. Consulting firms extended offers to 26% of the candidates. ITES, E-Commerce, Sales & Marketing constituted 20% and 17% of the roles offered to the students respectively. **Accenture Strategy, BCG, Amazon, Hindustan Unilever, Tata Steel and Bajaj Auto** made the highest number of offers. Other top and legacy recruiters include but not limited to Aditya Birla Group, Asian Paints, Bain & Company, ITC, IndigoEdge, JP Morgan Chase & Co., McKinsey, P&G and TAS. New recruiters include Accenture Technology Consulting, BMW, ClearTax, DE Shaw, Godrej Properties, L'Oreal, Michael Page, Ola, Philip Morris, Simpl, StrategyTech Advisors, Sutra Management Consulting, and Thoucentric to name a few.



Sectoral Overview

Consulting

XLRI continued to be the destination of choice for consulting firms such as Accenture Strategy, Accenture Technology Consulting, Aon, Auctus Advisors, Bain & Company, Boston Consulting Group, Deloitte, Everest Group, Ernst & Young, EY Parthenon, Intucri Consulting, Kearney, KPMG, Michael Page, McKinsey, PricewaterhouseCoopers, Samagra Governance, StrategyTech Advisors, Sutra Management Consulting, Vector Consulting and others participating in the process. The surge in consulting roles can be primarily linked to the influx of various new consulting companies recognizing the exceptional talent pool at XLRI, underscored by our rigorous pedagogical approach. This growing interest is further bolstered by the distinguished track record of XLRI graduates in esteemed management consulting firms both in India and internationally.

ITES, E-commerce, Gaming and Online Services

Despite the downturn in the tech sector market, recruitment remained robust in areas such as Product Management, Analytics, and Programme Management. A wide range of leading firms, including Amazon, American Express, Atlassian, Cleartrip, Coforge, Cognizant, Ekincare, Ergode, FedEx, Flipkart, Genpact, GyanSys, HCL Technologies, Hexaware, iLink Digital, Inme, Intellect, LTTS, Media.net, NG-Next, PhonePe, Pine Labs, PlayGames 24x7, Poshn, Renewbuy, Searce, Star Disney, Tata Communications, Tech Mahindra, Texas Instruments, Winzo, and Xiaomi, continued to actively recruit, showcasing the industry's resilience and the ongoing demand for skilled professionals in these key roles.

FMCG, Pharma and Real Estate

XLRI has established itself as a campus preferred by FMCGs, and the trend continued this year with top firms such as ABinBev, Amul, Asian Paints, Beam Suntory, Colgate Palmolive, Dabur, Diageo, Haleon, HCCB, Hindustan Unilever, ITC, Jubilant, L'Oréal, Marico, Mondelez, Nestle, P&G, Pepsico, Pernod Ricard, Philip Morris, Pidilite, Reckitt, Samsung Electronics and others participating. The process witnessed hiring by companies in the pharma chemical sector such as Sun Pharma, Becton Dickinson, among others. Real estate developers viz. Godrej Properties, Abhinandan Lodha Enterprises and Landmark Group participated in the process for the first time. Roles in Strategy, Sales & Marketing, Supply Chain, Operations, IT and Human Resources were offered to the graduating students.



BFSI

Description of Salary Heads

1. **Fixed Yearly Cash Component:** This is a total of the annual basic salary and additional guaranteed cash components. These additional components include cash payments and allowances that are part of the annual package. The term guaranteed signifies that the amount is certain unless there is an overall pay revision. The components falling under this salary head are the final and are not related to performance.
2. **One – time Cash Payment:** This head indicates the value of the remuneration given to a candidate as one-time cash benefit mostly at the time of joining.
3. **Total Guaranteed Cash Component:** This is the sum of fixed yearly cash component and one-time cash component.
4. **Maximum Earning Potential –** This is the sum of total guaranteed cash component, max possible-linked variable pay & all other components of salary that are a part of the offer.
